

## **The most important facts about PPR at one glance**

### **Why is PPR necessary at Linz Airport during the period 24.4.19. - 28.5.19?**

Due to increased traffic volume and reduced parking positions, a PPR regulation will apply in LOWL for this period. Please fill out the PPR form completely.

Please note that a PPR request must be made at least 24 hours prior to scheduled arrival and/or departure in LOWL.

### **Do I have to register every departure and arrival?**

Yes, every flight movement has to be requested.

### **Why does every flight movement have to be requested?**

Each A/C is assigned a parking position at the apron when it takes off or lands.

To coordinate this, we need a request for each flight movement.

### **Do A/C stationed in Linz also have to request their flights?**

Yes, every flight movement has to be requested, since A/C stationed in Linz also require a parking position on the apron for take off and/or landing.

### **Is it possible to request a flight at short notice, if I want to fly spontaneously?**

Of course it is possible to request for a flight at short notice.

However, waiting times may occur due to the increased volume of traffic if no parking position is available at the desired short-term arrival/departure time.

### **How are ambulance and rescue flights treated?**

For operational reasons ambulance and rescue flights must also request, of course these flights will be handled with highest priority.
